

Eligibility & Merit Point Calculation:

For Admission to	Eligibility criteria
Any Undergraduate course	Applicant must have passed H.S./Equivalent level examination in 2018, 2019, 2020 & 2021.
B.A./B.Sc. Honours	Minimum 45% marks in H.S./Equiv. level examination (Best performing five subjects to be counted. Marks of Environmental Studies will only be counted in best five, if it is within compulsory elective subject at 10+2 level, otherwise, it won't be counted).
B.A./B.Sc. General Course	Minimum pass marks (30%) in aggregate in H.S./Equivalent level examination
Course with practical based subject	Qualifying marks to be obtained separately in theory and practical components
Any Honours subject, not studied at H.S./ Equivalent level	Must have eligibility in allied subject (<i>Please see list of *allied subjects below</i>) as identified by the college, at H.S./equivalent level <i>and also relevance to the stream (Arts/Science) studied at 10+2 level</i>
Honours in Economics, Computer Science, Physics and Chemistry	Pass marks (30%) in Mathematics at H.S./Equiv. level is compulsory
Honours in Microbiology, Nutrition	Pass marks (30%) in Chemistry at H.S./ Equiv. level is compulsory

Merit Point Calculation:

Merit Point for Honours courses (M) = A + B + C	A = 40% of percentage of marks obtained at M.P./Equiv. level. B = 60% of *percentage of marks obtained at H.S./Equiv. level. C = Marks obtained in the Honours seeking subject/*allied subject at H.S./Equiv. level. (<i>*Please see page 8 for list of allied subjects</i>)
Merit Point for General courses (M) = A + B
